Homes and rents

At 31 March 2023 we owned 518 homes. The total rent due for the year was £1,948,778. We increased the weekly rent on average by 5.0% from the previous year.

Tenant satisfaction

Of the tenants who responded to our most recent tenant satisfaction survey:

- 92.8% said they were satisfied with the overall service we provided, compared to the Scottish average of 86.7%.
- 98.8% felt that we were good at keeping them informed about our services and outcomes compared to the Scottish average of 89.7%.
- 99.2% of tenants were satisfied with the opportunities to participate in decision making, compared to the Scottish average of 85.9%.



Quality and maintenance of homes

- 96.9% of our homes met the Scottish Housing Quality Standard compared to the Scottish average of 79.0%.
- The average time we took to complete emergency repairs was 2.0 hours, compared to the Scottish average of 4.2 hours.







• We completed 93.7% of reactive repairs right first time compared to the Scottish average of



- We do not operate a repairs appointment system.
- 96.4% of tenants who had repairs or maintenance carried out were **satisfied with the service** they received, compared to the Scottish average of 88.0%.

• 100.0% of these cases were resolved within targets agreed locally, compared to the Scottish figure of 94.2%.



Value for money

· The amount of money collected for current and past rent was equal to 104.7% of the total rent we were due in the year, compared to the Scottish average of 99.0%.



• We did not collect **0.1%** of rent due because homes were empty, compared to the Scottish average of 1.4%.



 We took an average of 10.2 days to re-let homes, compared to the Scottish average of 55.6 days.
